 - a. Evidence reception
 - b. Evidence processing

13. Evidence storage
14. Patrol equipment storage
15. Armory
 - a. Secure storage of police department weapons, ammunition, and less-than-lethal weapons
16. Cell block
 - a. Two cells are sight and sound separate allowing for maximum flexibility. Can be used for any combination of gender or adult/juvenile
17. **Booking**
 - a. Holding pen allows for secure and safe temporary detention of prisoners while processing
 - i. Physical security and biohazard safety
 - b. Secure area for bail commissioner to work
18. **Interrogation**
 - a. Secure and safe area for questioning suspects and debriefing prisoners
 - b. Temporary holding
 - c. Attorney/client interview
19. Storage
 - a. Plumbed for future use as cell if needed
20. Sallyport
 - a. Secure transition of prisoner from cruiser to booking b. Extra parking during winter weather
21. Impound/maintenance garage
 - a. Cruiser parking during winter weather (increases response time and keeps sensitive equipment in correct temperature range)
 - b. Cruiser maintenance and washing
 - c. Area for detailed searches of motor vehicles
 - d. Impound area for vehicles being held as evidence
 - e. Storage for vehicle supplies
 - f. Future expansion area
22. Bulk evidence
 - a. Storage for large evidence/safekeeping items such as bicycles, beer kegs, etc.
