Unitil to partner with Fitchburg and Devens for residents to recycle outdated dehumidifiers

One-day event provides customers with \$30 to recycle old, working dehumidifiers.

Fitchburg, MA (April 14, 2016) — In an effort to increase energy savings and properly dispose of old appliances, Unitil is offering customers in Fitchburg, Ashby, Townsend, and Lunenburg \$30 for recycling an old, working dehumidifier.

Residential electric customers of Unitil from Fitchburg, Ashby, Townsend, and Lunenburg are eligible to receive \$30 for recycling an old, working residential (30-70 pint capacity) dehumidifier through the scheduled recycling events. Participants must pick up a rebate form provided at the event and submit the completed form online or by mail. Gift cards will be sent within 6-8 weeks after the form is submitted for processing.

Kevin Parse, Unitil says, "Not only will replacing these old appliances save on household energy consumption, but customers will be able to dispose of these bulky appliances in an environmentally responsible way."

May 7th – Devens Regional Household Hazardous Products Collection Center, 9 Cook Street, Devens, MA 01434

How:

- 1. Bring an old, working dehumidifier to one of the scheduled events for recycling.
- **2.** Drop off the dehumidifier and receive a recycling form from event staff.
- **3.** Complete the form and send for processing to the address provided on the form, or submit your form online at MassSave.com/Savings.





4. Receive a gift card for recycling in the mail within 6 – 8 weeks after form is sent in for processing.

Additional Requirements:

- Limit one dehumidifier recycling rebate per valid residential electric account
- The Fitchburg event is only open to Unitil customers who are residents of Fitchburg
- The Devens event is only open to Unitil customers that are residents of Ashby, Townsend, or Lunenburg
