#### **RESULTS OF SPECIAL TOWN MEETING** October 21, 2006

With a quorum present, the Moderator Peter Rourke called the meeting to order at 10:15AM. The reading of the meeting rules was waived. The warrant showed it had been properly served.

**Article 6.** The motion was made and seconded to transfer the sum of \$606.65 from the Group Health Insurance account to the Emergency Management Expenses account for the purpose of paying for a base radio antenna.
